Spotlight: Michael Harnish at Lowell Ryan Projects

Lining opposite walls and filling most of the long, narrow gallery space are twelve large-scale vertical paintings, six per side, by Fullerton-based painter Michael Harnish. Another suite of ten smaller paintings is installed along one wall in the upstairs space. Presented as a sequence but not necessarily a narrative, these idiosyncratic works have abstract and representational elements.
