Go out before it closes: Molly Surazhsky's solo exhibition at **Lowell Ryan Projects** in Mid-City, "**Miss Americhka**," combines self-portraiture with sculpture and installation to criticize America's involvement in Russian politics. The central piece to exhibit, "**Slava Culture War**," is a gown on a life-size model of Surazhsky that runs through both of the gallery's exhibition spaces, beginning upstairs and falling into the downstairs area like a tapestry. 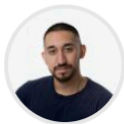
